In 2014, Crimea reunited with the Russian Federation. On August 4, 2014, a decree launching V. I. Vernadsky Crimean Federal University was issued.

The decree marked a significant milestone in the history of Crimean science and created new opportunities for the development of higher education in the region.

The oldest university of the peninsula occupied the 10th place and became the youngest federal one in the country, having gathered in its structure the leading educational institutions of the peninsula.

Nowadays, V. I. Vernadsky Crimean Federal University is the main scientific, educational and cultural centre of the region. It includes 5 academies, 6 institutes, and 6 colleges, which provide higher and secondary vocational education training. Structural subdivisions, branches and scientific organizations of the university are situated all over Crimea.

There are also more than 50 educational and scientific laboratories, 3 engineering centers, 6 shared-use centers, military department and St. Luke's Multi-Purpose Clinical Medical Centre in the university.

The current acting rector is Professor and Doctor of Engineering Andrei Falaleev.



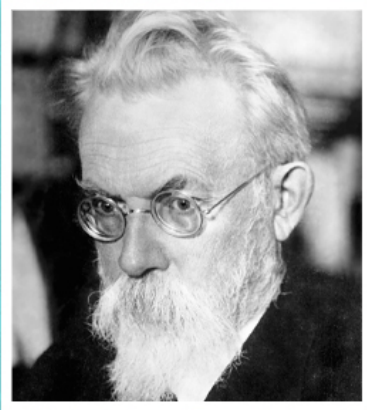

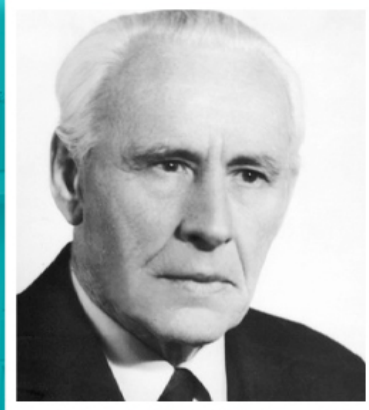

THE HISTORY OF MA CFU*

The outstanding Soviet scientist, naturalist, the founder of geochemistry, biogeochemistry and noospherology applied to the Taurida University (now - V. I. Vernadsky CFU) as a lecturer at the course of geochemistry in the beginning of February in 1920. In October of 1920 he had already been chosen as the rector of the university.

In 1951, the Soviet pathophysiologicalist became the Rector of the Crimean Medical Institute (now the Medical Academy of V.I. Vernadsky CFU). He improved the material and technical base of the university and raised to a new level its scientific activity. With his personal participation, great scientists who founded their own scientific schools in the Crimea were invited to work the university.



1931 – foundation of the first medical school in the Crimea, Crimean Medical Institute.

1981 – the Government Award of the Red Banner of Labor for excellent training of healthcare professionals and great achievements in scientific research.

1998 – the Institute was reorganized into Crimea State Medical University named after S.I. Georgievsky.

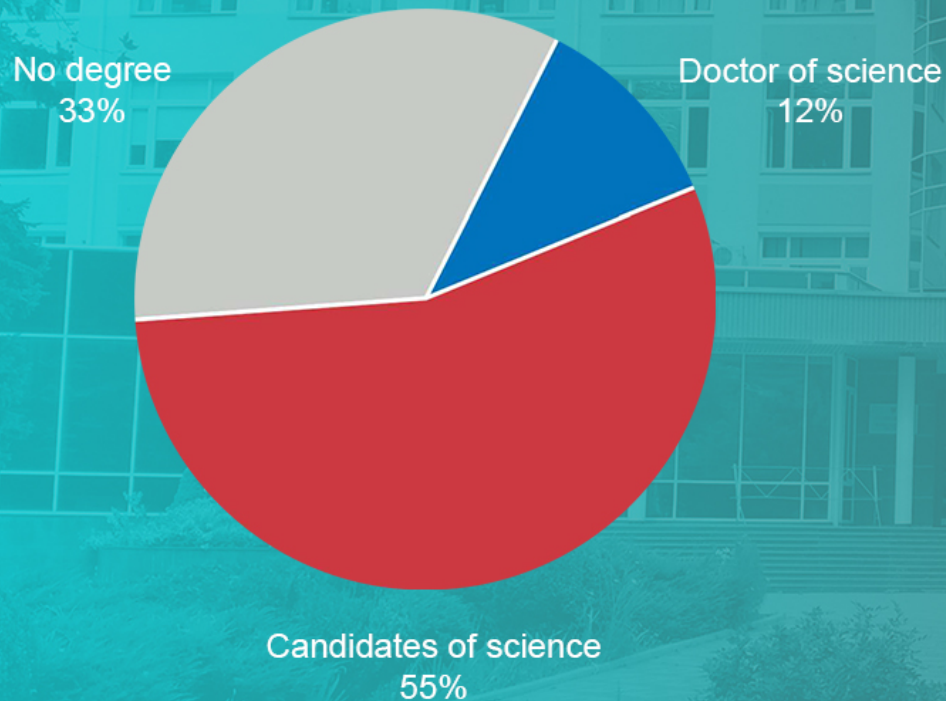
2015 – Medical University becomes a structural unit of CFU and has been known since then as Medical Academy named after S.I. Georgievsky (MA)

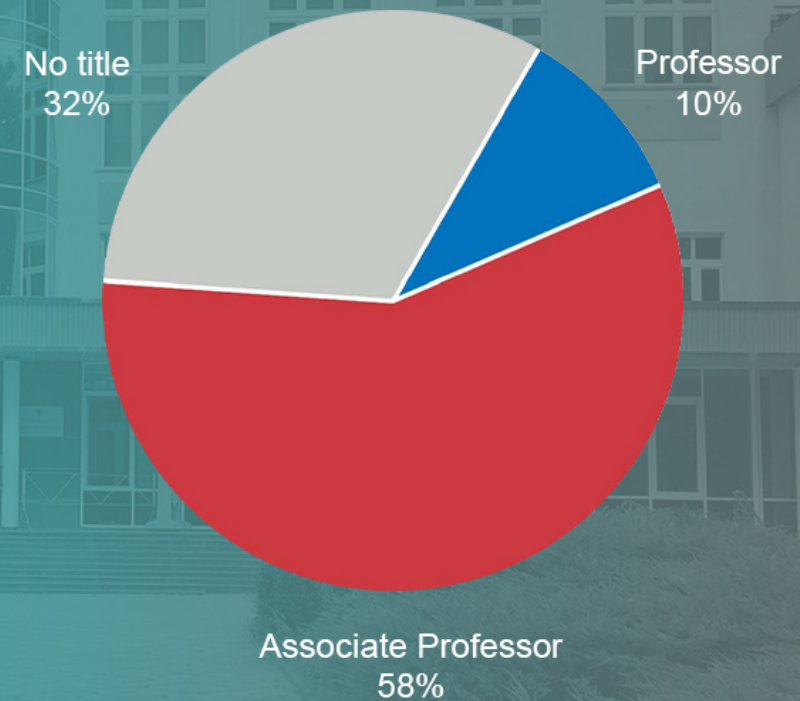

SIGNIFICANT STAGES IN TRAINING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AT MA



1961 – first international students enrolled at Crimean Medical Institute.

1966 – Dean Office for foreign students was organized in Institute to deal exclusively with international students.

1994 – formation of International Medical Faculty to cover growing needs of an increasing number of students from different countries.

1999 – Medical University was the first in Ukraine to educate international students in English. Since then, it has been the leading medical school in this field.



ST. LUKE CLINICAL MEDICAL MULTIDISCIPLINARY CENTER

St. Luke clinical medical multidisciplinary center began to function in 2005 on the campus of the Medical Academy of the Crimean Federal University. Now it is a modern center for training undergraduate and graduate students, conducting researches and treating patients. The modern equipment is used for both biochemical and instrumental studies, including CT scan, digital radiography and ultrasound studies.

The clinical multidisciplinary medical center includes a polyclinic department, departments of surgery, traumatology and orthopedics, therapy, radiation diagnostics, laboratory research, organizational and methodological work, anesthesiology and intensive care, as well as a medical biophysical center. The clinic employs doctors of the highest category with extensive practical experience, who carry out complex operations and relevant scientific researches.



University Clinic, situated on the territory of the campus, was built and started functioning in 2005. Now it is a modern center for training students and postgraduates, scientific research and treatment of patients.

The Clinic enjoys all types of modern equipment both for biochemical tests and instrumental studies, including those for computed tomography, digital radiography and ultrasound investigations.



MEDICAL EDUCATION FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS

The first foreign students entered the Crimean Medical Institute (now the Medical Academy of the Crimean Federal University) in 1961. In 1966, the dean's office for working with foreign students was established, and in 1994 the international medical faculty. Nowadays, over 2500 specialists have been trained for the health authorities of almost 100 countries.

Currently, over 4,500 students are studying at the Medical Academy of the Crimean Federal University and about 1,500 of them are foreign citizens from countries such as India, Uzbekistan, Ukraine, Jordan, Nigeria, Palestine and others. Training of specialists is carried out under such educational programs as «General Medicine», «Pediatrics», «Dentistry» and «Pharmacy».



Foreign students are active members of student scientific societies that are created in all departments of the Academy. They conduct researches and report on their work at international scientific conferences.

A high level of education of students provides an academic staff, which includes over 600 specialists. Crimean Federal University is in the TOP-10 of the best universities for passing the MCI (Medical Council of India) exam.



TEACHING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Pre-medical Department of Medical Academy CFU trains 70 to 100 international students every year to help them enter the University.

The course includes intensive training in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Russian as a foreign language, as well as assists the students in getting used to life in the Crimea.

Academic training is provided in both Russian and English languages. More than 300 highly experienced English speaking lecturers are involved in teaching international students.



Students Anas Ali Qasem Abu Jad (Jordan) and Karyofyllidis Ioannas (Greece) became laureates of the Youth Creativity Competition “It is for us to decide” and were invited to Moscow to visit the RF State Duma Committee for Education and Science. They were awarded a 2 place Diploma, and thus they proved again the high quality level of education the Medical Academy provides.



STUDENT ACCOMMODATION & THE CAMPUS



Five modern hostels (total area of more than 30,000 m²) having comfortable apartments for 2-3 people accommodate more than 2,000 students and postgraduates (mostly from abroad) on the territory of the Academy Campus.

The hostels are situated near a picturesque park, and it takes students 5 minutes to get to their teaching labs, lectures halls or sports facilities.





SPORTS FACILITIES

The University is proud of its sports facilities (total area 16,086 m²) which include three buildings, an athletics track, a stadium and two sports grounds. There is also a swimming-pool, 7 gyms, aerobics and basketball halls and tennis courts.

Students and the staff of the University are welcome to join sport clubs and take part in competitions in mini football, basketball, field athletics, wrestling, kick-boxing, Martial arts, volleyball, lawn tennis, ping-pong, badminton, aerobics and others.



Sports activities of our students are not limited by PT classes included into the curriculum. There are numerous sport events and competitions organized by Medical Academy, International Medical Faculty and Students national Associations. Besides, students can play sports at weekends and public holidays (football, basketball, volleyball, tennis, cricket etc.). The international students regularly participate in all sports events not only in Medical Academy, but also in the University as a whole, and always take awards. The Jordanian students are among the best football players in all CFU football competitions.



OUR ATHLETES

The student of the Physical Education and Sports Department of the Taurida Academy of the CFU named after V. I. Vernadsky. Pavel Doroshylov has become a world boxing champion among the students, having won in the finals over the boxer from Armenia. The Crimean athlete won in the weight category over 91 kilogram. The student gained the right to represent the country on the World Championship after winning the Crimean Championship, the Championship of the Russian Student Sports Union and four training camps.



The student of the Sevastopol Economics and Humanities Institute of the Crimean Federal University, a paralympian and a Merited Master of Sports Andrey Granichka set a world record at 100 meter breaststroke distance at the World Swimming Championship, held under the auspices of the International Paralympic Committee in London. The new record is 1 minute 27, 15 seconds. The previous record was also set by the Crimean sportsman. At the Championship the student won two gold medals, one silver medal and received the right to participate in XVI Summer Paralympics of 2020 in Tokyo.

GRIFFINS: The male basketball team of the Crimean Federal University, named “Griffins” became the champion of the Crimea according to the results of the 2018/2019 season, having defeated the experienced team from Sevastopol in the final.

This year, the Griffins also fought with the strongest student teams in Russia and took the final sixth place in the standings of the VTB Student League of the Student Basketball Association of Russia and fourth place in the super final of eight strongest league teams.





SOCIAL AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

All students from foreign countries are united into communities in view of their origin, ethnicity, religion, etc. There is a number of such communities functioning now at Medical Academy CFU, the biggest of them being:

Indian Students Association – over 700 students, Uzbek Students Association – around 200 students, Nigerian Students Association – about 40 students, Jordanian Students Association – 40 students and Palestine Students Association – 25 students.



The social and cultural activities of students and associations are aimed at developing cultural and universal human values, friendship and tolerance between nations and peoples, and international communication. It is achieved through participating in international and all-Russian festivals, creativity competitions, concerts and celebrations. The foreign students are pleased to take part in such events as “100 Cities of Russia”, “Peoples Friendship festival”, “Youth and Students Festival – We are Building a Bridge”, “International Forum of Foreign Students and Graduates”, International Forum “Friends of Crimea”, Festival of the Languages of Peoples of Russia.

The International Medical Faculty does its best to facilitate the participation of the international students communities in celebration national and religious holidays organized in Medical Academy CFU.

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
